- 2. To amend Schedule 3 in The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Order 2020 to append the items set out in Schedule 1 of this notice.
- 3.To amend Schedule 5 in The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Order 2020 to append the items set out in Schedule 2 of this notice.

Statement of Reasons

The Street-Hatfleld Peverel

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where it is considered that any parking is inappropriate and likely to severely impede the access of large vehicles delivering to local businesses. Removing parked vehicles will allow the unhindered access to the service areas regularly utilised by delivery vehicles.

The Paddocks-Witham

The road is within walking distance of the train station and town centre and is regularly utilised by motorists wishing to avoid local car parking charges.

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of vehicles parking for an extensive duration, where it is considered that this parking is inappropriate and likely to severely impede the access of large vehicles. It will also prevent access issues for local residents.

Chippingdeli-Witham

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles on a bend where any parking is a hindrance to traffic flow and access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the road runs. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as refuse freighters and those associated with the emergency services.

Bellingham Place-Kelvedon

The road is within short walking distance of the train station and is regularly utilised by non-residents and commuters wishing to avoid local car parking charges. A permit parking scheme will improve the parking provision for households included in the scheme and their visitors by preventing non-residents from parking during the stipulated times.

Church Hill-Earls Coine


The road is within short walking distance of the primary School and is regularly utilised by motorists dropping off and collecting children at the applicable times. The Introduction of additional double yellow lines in will ensure that access, flow of traffic and vision is un-obscured at key points, such as a junction, bend and roundabout. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote the access of larger vehicles.


Rayne Road-Braintree


The road is within short walking distance of the town centre and is regularly utilised by non-residents and those wishing to avoid local car parking charges. A permit parking scheme will improve the parking provision for households included in the scheme and their visitors by preventing non-residents from parking during the stipulated times.

Galleys Corner-Braintree

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where it is considered that any parking is inappropriate and likely to severely impede the access of delivery vehicles and those associated with the emergency services. Removing parked vehicles at junctions will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents. The provision of limited waiting parking bays will provide parking places for those wishing to visit local businesses.






