The effect of the Order:

1. To amend restrictions in the Borough of Colchester as follows: to introduce school entrance markings on Baronswood Way, Colchester, 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am 2.30pm-4pm on Entrance Markings' and on Camulodunum Way, Colchester, to 'No Stopping 8.30am-9.30am 2.45pm-3.45pm on Entrance Markings': to introduce 'Residents Permit Parking Area LA1 Mon-Fri 10-2pm excluding Bank and Public Holidays' on Longacre, Colchester; to introduce 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am 2.45pm-3.45pm' red route restrictions on Meadow Way, Abberton; to change the limited waiting bays on William Harris Way, Colchester, to 'Limited Waiting 8am-6pm Maximum Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 2 Hours'; to introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' on Churchfields in West Mersea, New Farm Road, Old Chapel Drive, Holly Road, Juniper Road, Villa Road, Tollgate Drive, Lucy Lane North, Dale Close, Halstead Road in Stanway, Colchester; and to introduce 'No Waiting At Any Time' junction protections on the junctions of Prior Way and Longacre, Roosevelt Way and Barn Hall Avenue, Brittany Way and Churchill Way, Thornwood and Mill Road and Stalin Road at its junctions with Mulberry Avenue, Normandy Avenue, Churchill Avenue, Roosevelt Way, Montgomery Close in Colchester and Paget Road and Taylors Road in Rowhedge. Also, to introduce 'No Stopping At Any Time' red route restrictions on Holly Road and the junctions of Holly Road and Blackberry Road in Stanway, Holt Drive and Maraschino Crescent in Colchester; Osprey Close and Western Approach and Osprey Close and Robin Crescent in Stanway, Colchester.

2. To amend Schedule 3 in The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 to append the items set out in Schedule 1 of this notice.

3. To amend Schedule 5 in The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 to append the items set out in Schedule 2 of this notice.

Statement of Reasons

Holly Road/Blackberry Road/Villa Road/Juniper Road-Stanway

The introduction of double yellow lines/double red route on the junction and associated roads, where none currently exist will serve to prevent parking and improve access to the site, providing improved lines of sight on exiting, benefiting all road users. Access to a regular bus service will also be improved.

Dale Close/Halstead Road/Lucy Lane North-Stanway

The permanent order for the restrictions on junctions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

Robin Crescent/Osprey Close-Stanway

The permanent order for the restrictions on the junctions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

New Farm Road-Stanway

The permanent order to extend the current restrictions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site which encroaches on the junction with London Road and into estate roads.

Tollgate Drive-Stanway

The permanent order for the restrictions is required to allow passing places for vehicles to use at the entrance into the estate. Parked vehicles left in situ serve to control traffic speeds.

Maraschino Cresent

The permanent order for the restrictions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site at the junction, particularly at school drop off/collection times.

Churchfields-West Mersea (small green)

The permanent order for the restrictions is required to prevent parking which obstructs vehicles as the road is not considered wide enough to accommodate parking on both sides of the highway.

Barn Hall Avenue/Roosevelt Way/Stalin Road/Churchill Way/Mulberry Avenue/Normandy Avenue

The permanent order for the restrictions on junctions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

Thornwood/Mill Road

The permanent order for the restrictions on the junction is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

Paget Road/Taylors Road-Rowhedge

The permanent order for the restrictions on the junction is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

William Harris Way

A change to the limited waiting times will promote and encourage visits to local businesses, with the current timings not sufficient.

Meadow Way-Abberton

A timed red route restriction close to the exit of the school, to accompany existing school restrictions will prevent access issues and promote safety, primarily during school drop off/collection times.

Camulodunam Way/Baronswood Way

Permanent orders are required to allow enforcement of school restriction markings currently in place on roads under private ownership. Preventing parking during school drop off/collection times will promote safety for all road users.

Longacre/Prior Way

The introduction of a residents permit scheme will ensure that parking associated with the nearby train station, is deterred and residents and their visitors have spaces to use. The conversion of a single yellow line on a junction, to a double yellow line will ensure that parking is removed where it is not considered appropriate at any time of the day.
