

The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment Number 29) Order 202*

Statement of Reasons

Mile End Road

The introduction of additional double yellow lines will serve to prevent parking and improve access along the road where parking close to the junction with Braiswick Lane and a limited waiting parking bay hampers the travel of larger vehicles. Lines will also provide improved lines of sight on exiting the junction, benefiting all road users. Access for a regular bus service will also be improved.

Roman & Castle Roads

The permanent order for the creation of additional permit parking spaces will serve to lessen the pressure currently existing on the scheme, providing residents and their visitors with more road space. Double yellow lines on corners and between bays will prevent parking where it is inappropriate and provide a passing place for motorists using the roads.

Victoria & Cambridge Road

The permanent order to change single yellow, timed restrictions to double yellow lines is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians, and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site which encroaches on the junction of Victoria & Cambridge Road, and a bend on Victoria Road.

The removal of one parking bay, close to a bend on Victoria Road, replaced with a double yellow line, will prevent parking, and improve safety at the site.

Oaks Drive

The removal of a parking bay and alteration to another will serve to improve access to residential properties regularly obstructed by parked vehicles, with double yellow lines positioned to prevent obstructions from occurring.

Manor Road/ Rawstorn Road/ Papillon Road/ Crowhurst Road/ St Albans Road

The permanent order for the creation of additional permit parking spaces will serve to lessen the pressure currently existing on the scheme, providing residents and their visitors with more road space.
