

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) (Civil Enforcement Area) And (On-Street Parking Places) (Amendment Number 41) Order 2022

Statement of Reasons

John Dowdell Close, Harlow , Essex

The permanent order is required to keep the access road clear of parked vehicles during times where it is considered that any parking is inappropriate and will increase the risks to other road users and pedestrians.

It is perceived that the close proximity to a school increases the risks during school times.

The development has been afforded allocated parking areas for residents, removing the necessity to use the access road to park during Mon- Fri 8 am – 8pm

Permanent Orders Section 1(1) of the 1984 Act states that local traffic authorities in England and Wales (outside London)² may make permanent orders for the following purposes:

- To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising;
 - To facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- To preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs; or
 - To preserve or improve local air quality
