
South Road - Harlow

The permanent order is required to keep the area free of vehicles parking, where it is considered that this parking is inappropriate and likely to severely impede the access to a business's service. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety, visibility and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as Heavy goods vehicles and those associated with the emergency services.


Permanent Orders Section 1(1) of the 1984 Act states that local traffic authorities in England and Wales (outside London)2 may make permanent orders for the following purposes:
