

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment Number 45) Order 2022

Statement of Reasons

Replace 'No Waiting Tuesday 7am-5pm' on both sides of The Hornbeams outside The Conyers to 'No Waiting Tuesday & Thursday 9:30am-12:30pm'.

The permanent order is required to keep the roads free of parked vehicles on certain days and times to allow for the collection of waste. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents.

This change is necessary to coincide with the change in waste collection days by the local council refuse teams.

Permanent Orders Section 1(1) of the 1984 Act states that local traffic authorities in England and Wales (outside London) may make permanent orders for the following purposes:

- To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- To facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
