#### The effect of the Order:

- 1. To introduce a "No Stopping At Any Time Except Taxis" bay on the south side of Manor Street outside No. 8 Manor Street.
- 2. To extend the "Restricted Parking Zone No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading At Any Time (Except in Signed Bays)" on both sides of Victoria Street approximately 9 metres east, to a point in line with the western property boundary of No. 1 Victoria Street.
- 3. To relocate the "Loading Only 20mins No Return Within 20mins" bay on the east side of Fairfield Road outside Braintree Library southwards approximately 6 metres.
- 4. To change the existing "Disabled Badge Holders Only Mon-Sat 2hrs No Return Within 3hrs" on both sides of Bank Street between a point in line with the southern property boundary of No. 9 Bank Street and No. 25 Bank Street to shared use "Disabled Badge Holders Only Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri, Sun and Wed & Sat 5pm-1am 2hrs No Return Within 3hrs/Permit Holders Only MT Wed & Sat 1am-5pm"
- 5. To introduce the provisions of a Market Trader Permit by way of definition and inclusion to Article 18 and Schedule 4 to the 2019 Order.
- 6. To introduce into Part 1 Interpretation, a definition of market trader into the Order and to introduce an exemption for market traders from waiting restrictions on High Street and Market Square on market days.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing tile numbers TL755 230 and TL755 227 revision 4 with revision 5.

- 3. The Map Schedule Legend to this Order only applies to the Map Tiles listed in this Order.
- 4. To introduce into Part 1 Interpretation a definition of a market trader
- 5. To add into Part 2 Article 7 an exemption for market traders on High Street and Market Square on market days.

#### **Statement of Reasons**

#### **Manor Street**

It is proposed to introduce a no stopping at any time except taxis bay on the south side of Manor Street outside number 8 Manor Street. The taxi bay is already marked on the carriageway and the proposal will add the bay into the order.

#### Victoria Street

It is proposed to extend the current restricted parking zone on both sides of Victoria Street from approximately 9 metres east to a point in line with the western property boundary of No.1 Victoria Street. This is to correct an anomaly where a small section of Victoria Street is not included in the restricted parking zone and is currently unrestricted.

#### **Fairfield Road**

The location of the current mapped loading only 20 mins no return within 20 mins bay on the east side of Fairfield Road near the library does not match the location of the marked bay on the carriageway. It is proposed to correct this by altering the traffic regulation order.

#### **Bank Street**

It is proposed to change the existing Disabled Badge Holders Only Mon-Sat 2hrs No Return Within 3hrs on both sides of Bank Street between a point in line with the southern property boundary of No. 9 Bank Street and No. 25 Bank Street to shared use Disabled Badge Holders Only Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri, Sun and Wed & Sat 5pm-1am 2hrs No Return Within 3hrs/Permit Holders Only MT Wed & Sat 1am-5pm. This change in restrictions reflects the change of use on Wednesday and Saturdays to accommodate market traders and disabled badge holder parking is not possible.

It is also proposed to extend the current no waiting at any time pedestrian zone to include all of Bank Street as currently a small area is not included in the traffic regulation order mapping.

### **Changes to Articles and Schedules in the Order**

To introduce the provisions of a Market Trader Permit by way of definition and inclusion to Article 18 and Schedule 4 to the 2019 Order.

#### To introduce to Part II, Article 7 (L)

In relation to Market Square and High Street Pedestrian Zone on Market Days, nothing in this order shall prevent a market trader, who is authorised to trade by

Braintree District Council, from waiting for the purposes of loading or unloading market stalls or any activity associated with market trading.

## To introduce to Part 1 – Interpretation

"Market Trader" means a person licensed by Braintree District Council to operate a market stall when a market is authorised by Braintree District Council.
