Oxford Road

Paid parking schemes can encourage the use of off-street car parks and encourage motorists to consider the use of other modes of sustainable transport. The conversion of bays will allow more efficient and effective enforcement and encourage a greater turnover of spaces (2 hours maximum stay), which will benefit nearby businesses. Dual use resident permit parking or pay parking (pay by phone) bays will still provide residents, their visitors and other motorists with parking spaces.

Permit provision (H permits) for the Hospital, now closed, will be removed.

Clarendon Way

Paid parking schemes can encourage the use of off-street car parks and encourage motorists to consider the use of other modes of sustainable transport. The conversion of bays will allow more efficient and effective enforcement and encourage a greater turnover of spaces, which will benefit nearby businesses. 




