Notice is hereby given Colchester City Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 1st July 2022 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on the East and West sides of Potter Street, Harlow between number 55 and Pinewood Close.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing tile numbers TL470 090 revision 1 with revision 2

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 82) Order 202x.

Statement of Reasons

1. To introduce a No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on the East and West sides of Potter Street, Harlow between number 55 and Pinewood Close.

Potter street is a well-used road on the edge of Harlow Town. The location is the site of a car dealership which uses the highway for parking of staff, customer and vehicle stock. This significantly reduces the road width and introduces an unnecessary hazard to road users as well as prevents the free flow of traffic.

The proposal will prevent parking of vehicles to allow free passage for vehicles.

The proposal will improve safety for pedestrians by preventing pavement parking

Permanent Orders Section 1(1) of the 1984 Act states that local traffic authorities in England and Wales (outside London)² may make permanent orders for the following purposes:

- To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- To facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- To preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs; or
 - To prevent damage to the road or to any building on or near the road

WHEREAS Colchester City Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 1st July 2022 in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-





1. The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.82) Order 202x and shall come into operation on XX XX XX.
2. This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 ‘the 2019 Order’ by:
 - a. replacing the following Map Tile:

TL470 090 revision 1 with TL470 090 revision 2
3. The Map Schedule Legend to this Order only applies to the Map Tiles listed in this Order.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by any other enactment.
