

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.89) Order 202x

Notice is hereby given Colchester City Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 1st July 2022 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a No Stopping at Any Time (Double Red Line) restrictions on the access road and the cul de sac of 235 to 245 Jerounds, Harlow.
2. To introduce a No Stopping at Any Time (Double Red Line) restrictions within the Cul de sac containing numbers 3, 4 and 4a Cock Green off Three Horseshoes Road, Harlow.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing tile numbers TL435 085 revision 1 with revision 2

Statement of Reasons

1. To introduce a No Stopping at Any Time (Double Red Line) restrictions on the access road and the cul de sac of 235 to 245 Jerounds, Harlow.
2. To introduce a No Stopping at Any Time (Double Red Line) restrictions within the Cul de sac containing numbers 3, 4 and 4a Cock Green off Three Horseshoes Road, Harlow.

The area within which this proposal is made is a new development of 13 residential properties with allocated parking areas. The developers wish to ensure that the entry road and Cul de Sac are kept clear of parked vehicles to ensure access at all times for waste collection and emergency vehicles.

WHEREAS Colchester City Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 1st July 2022 in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.89) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on XX XX XX.
2. This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 'the 2019 Order' by:
 - a. replacing the following Map Tile:

TL435 085 revision 1 with TL435 085 revision 2
3. The Map Schedule Legend to this Order only applies to the Map Tiles listed in this Order.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by any other enactment.
